Immerse yourself in Ancient Times at Holy Spirit's Vacation Bible School

Throughout the week of June 23rd to 26th children will have the opportunity to touch, feel, smell, create and experience life in the way Jesus and his contemporaries lived 2000 years ago at the Episcopal Church of the Holy Spirit in Verona.

“We’re really excited about our June Vacation Bible School. We’re transforming our church into Ancient Jerusalem this year to immerse the children and ourselves in the last week of Jesus’ life,” says the Reverend Lucy Ann Dure.

Learning more about Jesus’ life is what it’s all about. The children will gather as members of the tribes of Israel. They’ll wear tee-shirt togas and tribal bandanas. They’ll play games at the Jerusalem-on-Gould Street village playground, study at the “synagogue,” and explore the ancient marketplace. At the marketplace they’ll have the opportunity to take part in crafts like jewelry-making, pottery and woodworking from the period. The evening finishes up with a picnic dinner of Middle Eastern fare including pita bread, fruits, veggies and other kid-friendly stuff.

This year’s Summer Vacation Bible School takes place from 4:30 to 7:00 pm. The cost per child for all four nights is \$45. Families with more than two children receive a discount of \$35 for each additional child, and if you can’t come to all four nights, the price for a single night is \$15 per child. These prices cover all crafts, activities, and dinner. Everyone is welcome.
